



UE1: ANYTHING HELPS...?

DISCUSSION GUIDE

This sheet provides questions to guide your group through Urban Entry's "Anything Helps..." video. You probably will not have time to ask all the questions that have been provided, so review the questions ahead of time to decide which ones are most appropriate for your group. OPENING CONVERSATION (before watching the DVD):

- How do you respond when someone on the street asks you for money? Why? What experiences have you had?

DVD – 15 MINUTES

Some groups choose to pause the DVD at strategic points in order to discuss ideas/questions as they arise.

DISCUSSION (after watching the DVD):

- What ideas stood out to you from the DVD?
- When have you felt the need to fix someone...or felt like someone else was trying to fix you?
- Why would Penny say that anything helps...but anything could also hurt?
- Why would it be important to "share our pain and weakness before we share our strengths?"
- When you meet a homeless man or woman on the corner, which one of you needs help? Why?
- What are some practical ways you can respond when someone on the street asks you for money?
- Do you believe that when we serve those in need, we are actually serving Jesus? Really?
- Did God show you anything about yourself as you watched the DVD? Do you sense Him prompting you to respond to any particular needs around you?
