REVIEW THE BIBLE PASSAGES THAT WERE MENTIONED IN THE VIDEO:

- Matthew 28:18-20; Lev. 19:18, 33-34; Luke 10:25-37; Deut. 10:18-19; Romans 12:17-13:7; James 1:26-27
- How do these passages speak to your views on immigration?

VIEW DR. CARROLL'S TEACHING IN THE BONUS MATERIALS:

- Why do people emigrate? Do you know any people who have emigrated from another country?
- How do the accounts in Genesis and Ruth speak to the issues of immigration?
- What was the purpose of the Law in the Old Testament? How does the Law respond to the vulnerability of outsiders? How does that connect to our views on immigration today?
- Dr. Carroll talked about Old and New Testament passages. What connections or disconnections do you see between these Testaments?
- What can we learn from Jesus about treating those who are different from us?
- Dr. Carroll connected Romans 12 and 13 in the immigration discussion. What was your response to that?
