BIBLE STUDY

This is a Bible study for your group to use with Urban Entry's "Road Trip" video. The study is designed to be about an hour, including the opening conversation and the "Road Trip" video. Review the study and questions ahead of time to decide what material is most helpful for the purposes of your group.

OPENING CONVERSATION (before watching the DVD):

- What motivated you to go on this trip? Are you aware of any insecurities or concerns in the back of your mind? Think through each of your senses...what do you expect to see? Smell? Taste? Feel? Hear?

BIBLE STUDY: READ PHILIPPIANS 2:1-11 (after watching the DVD):

- This passage opens with a lot of instructions. What does Paul hope will motivate these actions?
- What is surprising about Jesus' attitude?
- How does this passage connect to the video you just watched?
- Reflect on these phrases—what would it mean to act like this as you go to volunteer?
 - "Did not consider equality with God something to grasp..."
 - "Made himself nothing..."
 - "Took on the nature of a servant..."
- Can you think of examples from Jesus' when he looked inside, looked up, looked out, looked around, and looked forward? How could you imitate one of those viewpoints?
